Universities and High Schools which are interested in sending candidates to this competition can contact the Secretariat.

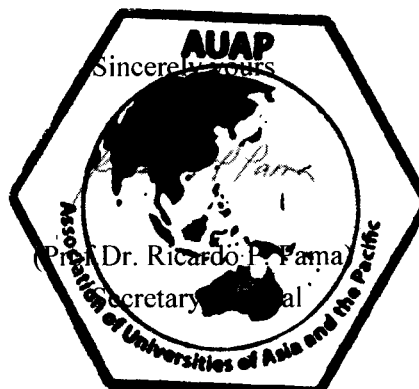

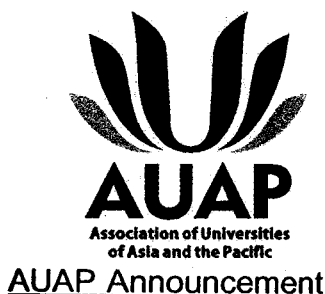

The criteria of applicants:

The AUAP Secretariat, in cooperation with Zhengzhou University (China), is pleased to announce the 1st AUAP-ZU Scholarships for the Year 2017 and tenable at Zhengzhou University, China. Fifty (50) students from AUAP member institutions will be selected to participate in the coming AUAP- ZU Scholarships for the Year 2017. Members in good standing of AUAP are encouraged to nominate their candidates (faculty members are included).

THE BASIC AUAP'S CRITERIA OF RECRUITMENT ARE LISTED BELOW:

1. Member institution nominating their candidates must be
 - an Active Member (i.e. has paid membership fees for the year 2017 and 2018)
 - or new Active Member (3 years membership payment; 2016-2018)
2. Each member can nominate 1 candidate.
3. Nominating institution must follow the following:
 - 3.1 submit an application (attached), photo and brief introduction of each candidate.

THE REQUIREMENTS FOR CANDIDATES, TO BE NOMINATED FROM AUAP MEMBER INSTITUTIONS ARE:

1. Holder of a Bachelor or Master degree
2. Grade Point Average must be reasonably high
3. Submit certificate, transcripts, letter of recommendation, written up proposal, copy passport, 1 photo (size 2 incs.)
3. Must pay the air ticket, personal expenses and insurance during their stay.

DEADLINE: Application form with the cover letter from the President/ Rector and Vice Chancellor must be sent to AUAP Secretariat on or before June 20, 2017 at 12.00 pm., Bangkok, Thailand Time.

The Secretariat will select the candidates and announce the results on July 31, 2017. Then, the host will issue the formal invitation for candidates to apply for a visa. The Academic Year starts in early September 2017.

Brief Introduction of ZZU

Founded in 1928, Zhengzhou University is the largest university in China with 46 schools (offering 110 bachelor, 256 master and 127 doctor programs), 72,000 students (57,000 undergraduate, 15,000 postgraduate and 1,800 international students), and nine affiliated teaching hospitals with 20,000 beds. There are 24 members of Chinese Academic of Sciences or Chinese Academic of Engineering (7 full-time and 18 part-time), 2500 professors, and other 2,000 academic members working in Zhengzhou University.

In China, Zhengzhou University ranked the 40th among 2000 universities and colleges. Four disciplines of chemistry, materials science, clinical medicine, and engineering have entered the top 1% in the Global Essential Science Indicator (ESI). In 2016, Zhengzhou University has obtained 198 National Projects in the areas of natural science, ranked the 34th; and 24 National Social Sciences and Humanities Fund projects, ranked the 35th in China. Zhengzhou University has established various collaborations with more than 200 universities from 60 countries or regions.
